POSITION	Tenure-track, nine-month Assistant or Associate Professor Position in the Department of Technology beginning August 2010.

RESPONSIBILITY	Primary responsibilities will include developing and teaching courses in the Industrial Design Program area, maintaining labs/studios, and providing instruction that allows students to succeed in their chosen area of study. Additional responsibilities will include recruiting and advising students, program development, and maintaining an active agenda of scholarly/creative and service work.
QUALIFICATIONS	An earned doctorate or a terminal degree in industrial design or a related field; professional experience; and significant knowledge and skills in computer applications used in the field are required. Preference may be given to candidates with experience teaching any or all of the following software platforms: Adobe Illustrator®, Rhino®, and/or SolidWorks®.
THE DEPARTMENT	The Department of Technology, which offers seven undergraduate majors with more than 900 students, is one of the fastest growing departments on the Appalachian campus. The Industrial Design program's most recent accolades include winning the regional and national Creative Juice competition, sending finalists to the AWFS student design competition, winning an innovation merit award in the AIAS "Chair Affair" competition, exhibiting at DesignBoom Mart in Copenhagen, and hosting the annual international Furniture Society Conference.
